- Write and edit manuscripts quickly, confidently and effectively
- Incorporate graphs, statistics and visuals into their text
- Organize writing into logical and coherent paragraphs
- Write informative yet concise abstracts
- Apply the IMRAD format to effectively write sections of their paper (e.g. introduction, materials & methods, results, and discussion)
